

OSHS PTSA Board meeting

Jan 11th, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm. In attendance were Lisa F, Melissa E, Paul Joseph, Kimmi S, Mercedes M, David S, Katherine B, Becky F, Denise R, Sidney B, and Jessica H.

There were a couple of corrections to the last meeting's minutes. These will be corrected and resent to everyone. (note- this has been already taken care of)

Kimmi motioned to move \$100 out of reflections (Bill seconded it) and move \$50 into admin and \$50 into hospitality. The motion was approved.

Becky- Treasurer's report- Stated that we are really hurting for money this year and we need to rethink our fundraising for next year.

Ms. OSHS pageant is this Sat- we are selling concessions as a fundraiser. (note- this was already done and we raised about \$120)

Bill- calendars- we will try to sell them for \$10 just to try and get some of our money back. Bill needs to reconcile the account for this. We will sell during lunches and at the wrestling matches.

Katherine presented yard sign for class of 2010. Signs are \$15 and we will try to show them to the Sr. class at their next meeting.

David and Denise talked about how the soup kitchen really helped a lot of kids have a good Christmas.

Jessica suggested selling ceiling tiles to raise money. Students could paint them and then flip them over if we need to.

Kimmi- scholarship forms are due March 31st.

Lisa- fundraisers coming up- Miss OSHS pageant (concessions), wrestling 50/50 raffle and maybe Buffalo Wild Wings night.

Sol testing right now- Ms. Rhodes might need help.

Feb 1st- schedules for 2nd semester- Ms. Rhodes might need help with those.

Mr. Joseph – trying to replace carpet in the auditorium and getting a bar for the edge of the stage to prevent accidents.

Nominating committee- needs to be voted on in Feb.
